About the Trainers - Our trainers for this seminar are world class. Many of the most active disciple makers today can trace their “training genealogy” back to one of these trainers. All serve on the International Executive Team for the Jonathan Project. Come learn from those who have actually started disciple making movements globally.

The Lead Trainer for this seminar will be **Dr. Curtis Sergeant** who served with the International Mission Board (IMB) as a pioneer church planting missionary among an unreached people group in China. When the work began to produce rapidly multiplying churches and he was no longer needed there, he transitioned to a ministry of training others to do the same sort of ministry. A few years later he began to interface with the major house church networks of China doing training and in a consultative role. Later he served as the associate vice president for Global Strategy with the IMB where he was also over the research department and continued in a training and consultation role for the agency. From there he went to Saddleback Church as the Director of Church Planting where he helped develop an online training system for missions and led some extremely large scale church planting projects, especially in India. During that period he was also instrumental in getting church planting ministry initiated in nearly a hundred previously unengaged people groups. He then served 3 years with e3-Partners Ministry as the International Vice President. Now he does disciple-making and missions training based out of Dadeville, Alabama. Curtis is married to Debie and they have 2 grown children, a son Nathan and a daughter Megan, plus a grandson.

Dr. Lee and Jan Bridges are the founders and International Coordinators for the Jonathan Project ministry. They have 30 years of Church Planting experience mostly in Asia and are based out of N. Thailand. When in the US, they live near Sacramento, CA to be close to their 3 sons and their families. Lee and Jan are regular presenters at Perspectives and Kairos and are adjunct faculty at William Jessup University and Bethel Bible Institute (Thailand).

Three other CPM catalysts will be joining in the training. **Andy Smith** who serves with OMF in the Philippines and **Terry and Amy Ruff** who serve with Team Expansion in northern Ghana.
