Greetings from Arizona Reservation Ministries!

"This isn't what we expected!"

I love you God. I know that doesn't come as a shock, but the things I especially love about God right now are his creativity, his sense of humor, and his faithfulness. GOD is definitely unique! With so many years on the mission field, sometimes it feels like we're in "auto pilot". Sometimes, routines need a bit of shaking up to remind us WHO is in control. God has been doing a lot of "shaking" lately. The number of teams on the calendar to come help us dropped this year. Another group that was scheduled dropped from ten to two members. With these groups come the funds we need for projects and programs planned. ARM was stretched financially as 2018 began, and that stretching has only gotten worse. The pool parties we love each summer with our Church Bus kids and their families couldn't happen, because the copper mine took over the country club and the pool.

GOD has not been surprised by any of this! Back in early 2018, a church generously provided an envelope filled with Walmart gift cards. Those funds have provided for a teen lock-in this past weekend, and two Vacation Bible Schools we're currently in the middle of. A friend donated Lowe's gift cards. When the groups cancelled/dwindled, we had already committed to the Vacation Bible Schools in partnership with Apache churches that are holding their summer revivals. These pastors had asked for this help way back in October at our Pastor Appreciation Banquet. A youth minister and his family joined in a prayer journey lately. He was moved by what he saw and heard. His youth group will be coming to help with next week's VBS, returning each evening to help. A group who had visited this spring had a couple who lead a home Bible Study. We asked for help! This couple asked their Study friends...and EACH member of that study was able to get time off work so that they are here now to help with this week's VBS. None but the first couple had ever been on a mission trip! The funds from the Lowes cards are enough to allow them to work during the day on one of the homes still under construction as they prepare their own meals, and add their ARMs in answer to our prayers. Our Church Bus has been out of commission for over a month! The closest bus mechanic is in Phoenix! Routine repairs have expanded into several problems, over \$5,000 in expenses, and a month with "no Bus." BUT, the team is providing two weeks of VBS! The pool party will now be two days of "Water" Family Fun Days in the neighborhoods, so that even more can be reached! GOD is in control!





That Teen Lock-in held unexpected things as well! Jon, Linda and Kevin spent days planning everything so that the kids would have fun, but primarily so that they would know even more about their Savior. They had an obstacle course at our 45 acres. Sins were candidly, truthfully, transparently recorded in red ink on canvases. They splattered those canvases with red-paintfilled balloons. Jesus' blood IS enough to cover them. Toward the end of the course, each team had to build a cross and then carry it up the hill to the offices, seeking what was in the treasure chest they'd been earning points to open. The chest revealed one word: heaven. I thought they'd be disappointed, but it sounds like they were thrilled. They understood that Jesus had provided the greatest treasure. With all of the games planned, movie, etc., consensus was that their crosses were the highlight. Even in this, Linda said, "it's not what we expected." We thought we knew who would come. GOD had amazing, wonderful plans. It was the boy who was with them on the oneyear anniversary of his mama's death and the girl who had buried her little sister (also an ARM Bus kid) four years ago. It was a girl who came every single week until she felt like she was too big...in a home with members of the Bloods. It was a dear "daughter" who just graduated high school and at the last minute, brought another recent Apache graduate, both on their way to the same college. I can't make this stuff up. God continues to amaze me. I'm praying you're amazed-and praising Him, too.

Dale and I still have flip phones. Mine is cracked, but still working. The monthly cost is something we can handle. BUT, we know that most of the rest of you most likely have smart phones. You can follow on facebook, read emails and much more from the small screen in your hands. Because of this, we know that how we communicate needs to shift as well. Donors in the past sent monthly gifts. Many of those contributing to us or this ministry now send their gifts electronically; sometimes, because they've just read something that prompts them to "click" on their phone. Things have changed, and we can't be too old to learn to change as well. Kevin and Jon went with me to a free workshop in Phoenix for Christian non-profits about database software. I just got off the phone with an organization that is nationally known for their assistance in teaching others to change, and helping them through the processes. Next Wednesday, I'm scheduled to attend a free workshop the area's United Fund is hosting about "Non-Profit Social Media."

When we moved to the mission field, I literally scotch-taped our family photo to the text we'd written on the computer, then printed each copy on an old Xerox machine. Things have changed! We need your help. First of all, please pray for us to have wisdom so that the changes we embrace are God-led. Secondly, to purchase software we'll need is expensive.
