Camp Plans are Underway

Natalka will once again be in French Camps this summer. Actually, she already participated in a camp that was hosted in France. French without Borders calls Natalka “my Russian language evangelist”.

Nastya will be in children’s camps. Actually, she is in one now and will be in another one next month. Here is her plan for the two camps, in her words.

I plan to participate in two camps in two different regions of Ukraine this summer. In June there will be a camp with PHA [Program for Humanitarian Aid] in Zaporozhye. The kids from Poltava and Zaporozhye orphanages are going to be there. Usually there are around 100-150 children there. I will be one of the interpreters there. I worked with PHA couple of years ago, know most of the children who are going to be there. So now I am looking forward to going back.

The other camp is with the former EEM, present BEYM (By Example Youth Missions). There I am going to be the team leader and lead interpreter for the second year in a row. The camp is going to be held in our favorite “Mayak” (“Lighthouse”) camp site in the Poltava region. Orphans from Poltava and Kremenchuk spend the whole summer there, but I know that some kids come specifically on the dates when our team is there. Thus, for three or four years in a row we’ve had many of the same kids we work with. So going to “Mayak” is like a huge family reunion with around 200 family members – my favorite time of the year.
