# **Creative Scripture Impact** It takes a team to share God's message

We are always looking for creative ways to get God's Word into the hands and hearts of the Lele people. When Jonas and others go to unreached villages to preach the good news, they love to share materials that further explain the message of Jesus.

Recently we used portions of the recently translated Luke text to make a French-Lele calendar focusing on the Life of Christ. As we reflect on how it came together we are thankful for all the people who helped in the process.

First of all our friend Jonas spent months studying the scripture in French and finding the best words to get it translated into Lele.

Over the past few years, Marc has been working with Jonas on the exegetical checking stage—making sure that the text communicates the ideas in the original Greek text as Luke wrote it in the first century AD.

Further corrections make the text more accurate and understandable.

In addition, there are various checking stages for the text. We test it for comprehension with villagers. We have an outside consultant look at our work to help us make it even better.

Then there is all sorts of editing that takes place—spelling and punctuation corrections, adding quotation marks where needed, Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. 1 Peter 4:10

We've been part of putting together a few booklets through the years. A project like this pretty much takes over the print shop for the week or so it takes to get it done.



Jeany sent us pictures of the process. One thousand Lele calendars were printed and put together by the middle of September. Now another question came up. How were we going to get all

these calendars transported up country from the capital out to the Lele villages? We're currently in the US so we couldn't do it until mid January, when we plan to be in our village. We wanted our Lele friends to have this in their hands before the new year begins.

Thankfully, our colleague, Yancy Fariss, was heading up to that part of the country to do Bible translation work so he took the calendars with him. Pierre took a taxi to meet him and picked up the calendars to take to the Lele villages, where people have begun to hang them on their walls. What a blessing!
