# Greetings from Arizona Reservation Ministries!



As I was considering what to share of the countless events that have occurred since our last News was



sent, there was no doubt about one of these that we would need to share. However, as we gathered for our ARM Team Meeting, it was abundantly clear that, once again, God had an even better addition to this story! Each February we are excited to transport a group of ladies to a Women's Conference in Phoenix. We mentioned this in our January news, and are deeply grateful for the prayers of many as this unfolded! As always, we had no idea exactly who would join us until we were heading out of Globe and down to the valley. Two older women were unable to attend at the last moment, allowing two younger women to literally throw things in bags as Linda and I headed from Globe to the Reservation to gather the ladies. This year I got to have these two and another young mom in my room. Linda, once again, had young ladies, but also the mother of one. These young ladies are part of the HANDS youth group of

ARM. One of these had voiced her desire to be baptized on this trek. Over six weeks prior to the event, I was making hotel reservations. All of those we had visited in the past were already booked. We had to go to a new hotel. In the Phoenix area, there is no need for an indoor pool. GOD provided an indoor pool...with a curfew of midnight! Hali packed a dress to wear over her swimsuit, because "you always wear a dress to a special occasion." Her best friend accompanied Linda into the water for this great event. Afterward, another teen was baptized! I had told her mom that she should be in the pool too, helping her daughter begin this new life. After Makenna was baptized, most of the 22 women with us were gathered to pray and witness such a grand event. We extended the invitation to them as well. Makenna's mom's response was, "What about me?" And so, Makenna and Linda baptized Joy. Several of the women stood to accept Christ during the Conference! A few made the practical connection of one of the lessons: "God doesn't fail anyone. He just keeps giving us the test until we pass." They walked to a restaurant and passed up quicker seats at the bar, and the temptations there, to wait for a table and not drink. WE thought these were amazing stories to share with you. (And, they most certainly are!) Later at our Team meeting, it was discovered that Hali's mom has been attending the church where Vincent and Vermaleen (our newest team members) serve. Hali came home enthusiastically proclaiming what she'd done, which then challenged her mom, and is impacting her whole family! God always sees a much wider picture than our small "screen-shot." We thank God for those who contributed toward this event! ARM's General Funds partners provided the balance we needed. His plans are perfect!







We have welcomed a few groups, already, this year. More are due to arrive soon! A group of families joined us this past

week from Palm Valley Church in Goodyear/Buckeye AZ. What a blessing it was to have these adults and children join us! They worked to begin the foundation for the addition at the American Indian Church. That church has been in existence for decades. It is so exciting to watch as the Holy Spirit breathes new life into this body of believers! Lord willing, with the assistance of our team and visiting short-term ministry teams, they'll have Sunday School rooms and restrooms, sometime in 2019! We gathered with this church in worship and in laboring. Several from Palm



Valley shared in worship and their testimonies, including two little boys. I'm sure you can imagine the smiles and joy as even these little ones shared Christ with all! On Monday, this team added their ARMs to provide a Family Fun Day in the area where this church exists. As 2018 began, our team had felt compelled to pray for this area; an area we had



rarely visited simply because of the vastness of the Reservation and the size of this small ministry. BUT, GOD is BIG and



again, God's plans are perfect! Fliers were created for the American Indian Church to share with those who visited the Fun Day about the many opportunities offered by them. One young man showed up. Dressed in all red to represent his gang affiliation, we knew instantly who he was. For many years, (over a decade ago!) he had attended the Church Bus. In spite of a physical handicap, his basketball abilities were phenomenal. As I hugged this young man on Monday, he winced. He had been shot by the rival gang,

hospitalized, and was recovering. We got to meet his super-cute son and daughter. His parents came as well, and shared quite a bit with Dale. Our plan is to provide alternate clothing for him, as he's relocated to his parents' new home, and says he was given "a wake-up call." We're also hoping to provide furnishings for them as they have nearly nothing. Tables, chairs, beds and a sofa will, Lord willing, be delivered from ARM soon! Vincent also talked to this family. "Grandpa" and "Grandma" were encouraged to return to church. "Grandpa" asked for a Bible. The Palm Valley group had brought Bibles for the Fun Day. I shared with Vincent that ARM would take care of this family's physical needs, and he and his church would handle their spiritual needs.

Dale and I had the great privilege of visiting First Christian Church in Yuma this past month. This church has been a practical partner with us since our beginnings in 1991! Dale was able to preach at their Sunday morning services while I shared with their youth and children's ministries. We thoroughly enjoyed visiting with them, and were incredibly blessed that at three separate gatherings, they ended with us encircled by those in attendance, praying over us. Those conversations and prayers were healing to us, as we serve each day on a mission field that honestly is a spiritual warzone. We were also able to share a meal with a young man who had served with ARM for years on our construction team as one third of the "A Team." Macaiah has been in the Marines for several years now. We are so proud of him as he continues to keep his eyes on the Lord, and receive promotions through such a vital part of our country's critical defense.



We have very special events in the next few weeks within our family that we are asking you to pray for! Jon will be having his pace maker surgery on Thursday, March 28<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 a.m. in Mesa AZ. Please pray for the surgeons, for his wife, kids, and the rest of us to have peace as this unfolds.
